Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume S 2-20013 C
at Page 1 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
March 6, 1972; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.02 cubic feet per second, 2 acre-feet per year, during entire year for group
domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

That part of the NW¹/₄ of Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the southeast corner of said NW¹/₄ of Sec. 34, ; thence north 0°40'49" west along the east line of said NW¹/₄, Sec. 34, 454.74 feet; thence south 77°12'20" west 51.40 feet to a point on the south edge of a 60 foot wide driveway and the true point of beginning; thence continuing south 77°12'20" west along the south edge of said 60 foot wide drive 738.95 feet; thence south 08°06'30" east 172.32 feet to the north edge of the right of way of the Washougal River Road; thence northeasterly along the said right of way to a point which bears south 11°22'08" east from the true point of beginning; thence north 11°39'08" west 86.32 feet to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
