

DEED OF TRUST

WE, THE WITNESSES, do hereby make this our day 15 of September of the year 1926, to have full force and effect from and after the date of delivery of this Deed, between us and between the Congregation of the Evangelical Free Church of North Gwinnett, Inc., of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia, hereinafter called the "Congregation", for the following named purposes:

1. The trustee shall borrow only to trustee, KIRKMAN HALL, on the subject property and shall hold a balance of \$10,000.00 and \$100.00 as well as his household interest, for the benefit of the Congregation. The trustee shall execute all documents necessary to accomplish these purposes and all documents necessary to provide for the safety and payout of any debt incurred for said purpose.

2. That the sum of \$10,000.00 shall have the date, recognition or signature of any member of the Congregation, and the Congregation, by vote of a majority of its members, shall have the date, signature or initials of such member, shall have the right

to require the trustee to make payment of the improvements herein, which may be required for the furtherance of the purposes of this Deed, or for the furtherance of the purposes of the Congregation, with

DECLARATION OF TRUST

WE, THE SUBSCRIBERS, do hereby state that for and in consideration of the documents which we have to the principles and teachings of our faith, do hereby agree to hold the household interest described in that certain Assignment of Lease bearing even date herewith by and between Lyle Godfrey, on behalf of the Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, of North Dumontville, Washington, as assignor, and David Green, Gen. Ulrich and Lyle Godfrey, as assignees, in trust, for the benefit of the Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, of North Dumontville, Washington, hereinafter called the "Congregation", for the following uses and purposes:

1. The trustees shall borrow money to construct a Kingdom Hall on the subject property and shall hold evidence of title to said Kingdom Hall as well as the household interest, for the benefit of the congregation. The trustees shall execute all documents necessary to accomplish these purposes and all documents necessary to provide for the orderly retirement of any debts incurred for said Kingdom Hall.
2. The trustees further agree that upon the death, resignation or disqualification of any number of trustees of the congregation, that the congregation, by vote of a majority of the active members at the time of such event, shall have the right to appoint a successor trustee or trustees.
3. In the event the subject property, or the improvements thereon, cease to be used as a Kingdom Hall, or equivalent church facilities for the furtherance of the congregation, we, the undersigned trustees, or our successor trustees, will execute all documents necessary to liquidate the holdings of the congregation which we are trustees for, first to apply to existing indebtedness incurred in the construction of the Kingdom Hall, second to other indebtedness of the congregation, and third, any remaining funds shall be transferred to the name of Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses in existence at that time.
