CERTIFICATE OF GROUND WATER RIGHT

(Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 233, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology thereunder.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That DARRELL A. TILLOTSONof Carsen, Washington, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public ground waters of
the State of Washington from a welllocated within BLM-NE-SW₄

Sec. 26, Twp. 4 N., R. 7 E. W.M.,

for the purpose(s) of domestic supplyunder and specifically subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. G 2-00547 P

issued by the Department of Ecology and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been per-

fected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology

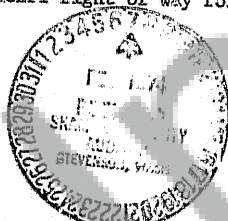
and entered of record in Volume _____ a page G 2-00547 C; that the priority of the right hereby confirmeddates from October 7, 1971; that the quantity of ground water under the right hereby con-

firmed for the aforesaid purposes, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes,

and shall not exceed 10 gallons per minute; 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year

for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of BLM-NE-SW₄, Sec. 26, T. 4 N., R. 7 E.W.M.; thence south 132 feet to true point of beginning; thence east 330 feet, more or less, to intersection with the westerly right of way of county road known as Trout Creek Road; thence southwesterly following the westerly line of said road to intersection with the west line BLM-NE-SW₄ of said Sec. 26; thence north to true point of beginning; EXCEPT right of way for county road known as Trout Creek Road.

The right to use of water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390 and 90.44.020.

This certificate of ground water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
