## DECREES OF ADJUDICATED WATER RIGHTS

This is to certify:

That by virtue of a decree made in the Superior Court of the State of Washington on and for  
December 1, 1912, and entered on the 22nd day of December, 1912,  
in the cause of State of Washington v. Elmer A. Ellodge and Minerva Elledge, his wife, et al.

County Court No. 1102, it is now determined the rights of all known claimants in the  
order of the decree, as follows:

In accordance with Chapter No. 1102, Revised Code of Washington.

Elmer A. Ellodge and Ruth A. Ellodge

Somers, Washington

are entitled to the, subject to priorities set forth in said decree, and the laws of the State of Washington, the waters of Ketzner Spring, tributary to Spruce Creek,

for the purpose of

domestic use.

The water right is confirmed in the amount of water that is reasonable, and actually necessary for the purpose aforesaid and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, as needed, up to exceed 1 acre-foot per year.

That the decree aforesaid establishes said right in Class III with a priority date of 1912.

That the approximate point(s) of diversion are as follows:

Point No. 1 - 750 feet north and 25 feet west of the south quarter corner of Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., being in the NESESW of said section.

Point No. 2 - 475 feet north and 200 feet east of the south quarter corner of Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., being in the SWSENE of said section.

That said water right can be adjudged by said decree to be undivided and appurtenant to the following described real property located in Skagit County, Washington, to wit:

Bounding at the southeast corner of the NW1/4 of SW 34, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M.; thence west 420 feet; thence west 420 feet; thence SW 1/4 420 feet; thence east 420 feet to the point of beginning.

### CERTIFICATE OF ADJUDICATED WATER RIGHT

This is to certify:

That by decree of a decree of the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for Skamania County, made and entered on the 22nd day of October, 1970, in the case of State of Washington v. George Alvey and Winifred Alvey, his wife, et al.

County Court No. 4790-A, which decree determined the rights of all known claimants to the use of the waters of Spring Creek, drainage basin

in accordance with Chapter 90.03 and 90.14 Revised Code of Washington.

Elmer E. Ellerbe and R. C. Ellerbe

Skamania, Washington

are entitled to use, subject to priorities set forth in said decree and the law of the State of Washington, the waters of Waterfall Spring, tributary to Spring Creek

for the purpose of

domestic use.

The water right is confined to the quantity of water that is reasonably and actually necessary for the purpose aforesaid and shall not exceed .002 cubic foot per second, as needed, not to exceed 1 acre-foot per year.

That the decree aforesaid entitles said right in Class III, with a priority date of 10/22/70.

That the approximate points of diversion are as follows:

Point No. 1 - 750 feet north and 25 feet west of the south quarter corner of Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., being in the NESE&SW of said section.

Point No. 2 - 475 feet north and 200 feet east of the south quarter corner of Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., being in the SWSE&NW of said section.

That said water right was adjudged by said decree to be and is copurtenant to the following described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the NW&NE of Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., thence north 420 feet; thence west 420 feet; thence south 420 feet; thence east 10 feet to the point of beginning.

Any changes in these rights can only be in compliance with Chapters 90.03 and 90.14 RCW.

This certificate of adjudicated water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in Chapter 90.14 RCW.

This instrument is recorded in the office of the Department of Ecology, Olympia, Washington, in Volume XI, of Adjudicated Water Right Certificates, at Page 13.
