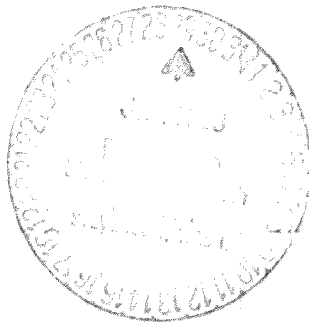
## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that DEAN R. BAUGUENESS  
of North Bonneville, State of Washington, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use  
of the waters of unnamed spring, ~~and~~  
with point or points of diversion within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
Sec. 14, Twp. 2 N., R. 7 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in  
appropriation Permit No. 12752 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and  
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,  
and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of  
record in Volume 18, at Page 8685, on the 24th day of January, 19 63;  
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is January 24, 1962; that the  
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount  
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second for domestic  
supply.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the  
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Section line between Sec. 14 and Sec. 15, T. 2 N.,  
R. 7 E.W.M. with the north line of the right of way of the North Bank Highway; north  
54°45' east 237.5 feet to the initial point of the tract herein described: north 3°15'  
west 722.43 feet; east 80.38 feet; south 26°15' east 332 feet; south 6°06' west  
320.43 feet; to the said right of way line, then along right of way south 54°45'  
west 187.5 feet to the point of beginning.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
