(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1911, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That RICHARD T. BLAISDELL, WILLARD J. KELLIE & WESLEY A. OBER, JR.  
 of Carson, Washington, has made  
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters  
 of the State of Washington from Panther Creek  
 a tributary of Wind River, with point of diversion within NE 1/4

Sec. 1, Twp. 3 N., R. 7 1/2 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply,  
irrigation and stockwater under and specifically subject  
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16775 issued by the  
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance  
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of  
 record in Volume \_\_\_\_\_, at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
February 22, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for

the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed  
0.06 cubic feet per second; 21.6 acre-feet per year from May 1 to October 31 each year,  
for irrigation of 20 acres; 3 acre-feet per year, during entire year for domestic supply;  
and 1 acre-foot per year, continuously each year, for stockwater.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Richard T. Blaisdell: the north 125 feet of the east 345 feet of the south half of  
 Government Lot 14, Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 7 1/2 E.W.M., LESS road.  
Willard J. Kellie: the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 7 1/2 E.W.M., LESS road.  
Wesley A. Ober, Jr.: the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 7 1/2 E.W.M., LESS road.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place  
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.  
 This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as  
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.
