NOTE: This joint Will shall become effective in the event of the simultaneous death of both of us or the death of both of us from any cause whatever under such circumstances that, should one predecease the other, the survivor has not had reasonable time and opportunity to or has not made a will subsequent to the death of the one of us dying first.

SECOND: Under the circumstances outlined above and should those circumstances come to pass, we do, jointly and severally, give, devise and bequeath, as follows:

Firstly, we give and bequeath to India Bell Rike, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and her choice of one of the oil paintings.

Secondly, we give and bequeath to Walter Henry Rike, Jr., the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and his choice of one of the oil paintings.

Fourthly, to our son, Robert Hamilton Rike, his father's wrist watch and his mother's wrist watch and one-half of all the rest, residue and remainder of our estate, both real and personal of whatsoever nature and description, and wheresoever situated.

FIFTHLY: We hereby nominate and appoint Mr. Hoy F. Reed and/or Mrs. Sarah Margaret Reed, if alive, or Mary Louise Straley, the executors of this our last joint will; and it is our will and we hereby direct that no bond or security of any nature be required of our said Executors as such by any court; and that no proceedings be had or taken in any Court in the settlement of administration of our estate, other than such as may be necessary for the purpose of proving and recording of this our Last Will, it being our intent and purpose to give, and we do hereby give

unto our said Executors full power and authority to settle our estate in the manner herein provided and to carry out the intent and purposes provided in our individual wills of this same date.


