## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that C. FAMELOS

of Ringen, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of 2 unnamed springs, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the H. Shepard D.L.C. Sec. 36, Twp. 3 N., R. 7½ E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 13045 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 18, at Page 8780, on the 10th day of June, 1963; that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is February 5, 1963; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 of a cubic foot per second for domestic supply for two homes.


A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Commencing at a point 31.47 chains east of the southwest corner of the N½ of the H. Shepard D.L.C., said corner being 15.75 chains east and 20.97 chains north of the quarter corner to Sec. 1, T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M. and Sec. 36, T. 3 N., R. 7½ E.W.M.; thence north 17°07' west 24.52 chains; thence east 21.33 chains; thence south 17°07' east 24.52 chains; thence west 21.33 chains to the place of beginning. ALSO: commencing at the same point of beginning as the above described; thence in a southeasterly direction along the bed of a small creek 3½ chains to the north line of the North Bank Highway (State Road No. 8); thence north-easterly along the north line of said highway to intersection thereof with the south line of the above described tract; thence west along the south line of the above described tract to the place of beginning. EXCEPTING from the above the following tracts sold and deeds recorded as follows: Henry Johnson, deed recorded in Book H. of Deeds, page 507; Henry Hickey, deed recorded at page 437 of Book M of Deeds; Henry Hickey, deed recorded at page 321 of Book N of Deeds, I. W. Ward, deed recorded at page 323 of Book N of Deeds; States and Co., deed recorded at page 297, Book Q of Deeds, all records of Skamania County Washington; ALSO EXCEPTING right of way to State of Washington for State Road No. 8

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
