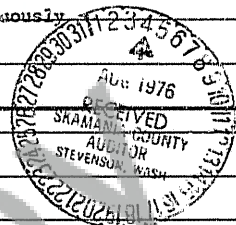

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY WATER TO BE USED ON



A tract of land in Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the southeast corner of said Sec. 27; thence west along the south line of said Sec. 27 with an assumed bearing of due west 810 feet; thence due north 69.15 feet to an iron pipe driven in the ground and at the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence north 66°01' west 68.1 feet; thence north 15°26' west 50.2 feet; thence north 23°59' east 61.2 feet; thence south 66°01' east 100 feet; thence south 23°59' west 100 feet to the initial point;

AND beginning at a point on the section lines common to Secs. 27 and 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., which is north 89°22'30" west 942.9 feet from the southeast corner of Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.; thence south 23°59' west 61.67 feet to the northerly right of way line of State Road No. 8; thence south 66°01' east along highway 262.64 feet; thence north 23°59' east 101.51 feet; thence north 66°01' west 262.64 feet; thence south 23°59' west 39.84 feet to the point of beginning;

AND a tract of land located in Secs. 26, 27, and 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows:

beginning at the section corner common to Secs. 26, 27, and 34, said point being marked by a brass monument established by the Skamania County Engineer; thence along the south line of the said Sec. 27 south 89°52' west 67.61 feet; thence south 01°36' east 176.44 feet to a concrete post; thence north 56°09' west 239.32 feet to a concrete post; thence north 66°14' west 222.14 feet; thence north 24°20' east 19.12 feet; thence north 66°01' west 43.48 feet to the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to Konrad L. and Ora J. Hauser by deed dated December 3, 1964, and recorded at page 385 of Book 53 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County; thence north 66°01' west 150 feet; thence north 280 feet; thence west 240 feet, more or less, to intersection with the east line of a tract of land conveyed to Fred and Mary Paasch by deed dated April 9, 1952, and recorded at Page 94 of Book 35 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County; thence north along the east line of said tract 205 feet, more or less, to a point 600 feet north of the south line of said Sec. 27, said point being the southeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Robert W. Barnes by deed dated January 28, 1947, and recorded at Page 279 of Book 31 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County; thence east 1,170 feet, more or less, to a point on the east line of the Jos. Robbins D.L.C., in said Sec. 26, said point being 600 feet north of the intersection of the east line of said Robbins D.L.C. with the south line of said Sec. 26; thence south 600 feet along the east line of said Robbins D.L.C. to the south line of said Sec. 26; thence along the south line of said Sec. 26 south 88°01' west 299.76 feet to the point of beginning;

AND a tract of land in Secs. 27 and 34, T. 3 N., R. 5 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the southeast corner of said Sec. 27; thence west along the south line of said Sec. 27 with an assumed bearing of due west 810 feet; thence due north 69.15 feet to an iron pipe driven in the ground; thence south 66°01' east 200 feet to the initial point of the tract of land hereby described; thence north 23°59' east 100 feet; thence south 66°01' east 75 feet; thence south 23°59' west 100 feet; thence north 66°01' west 75 feet to the initial point;

AND a tract of land located in the Jos. Robbins D.L.C. in Secs. 27 and 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at a point on the south line of the said Sec. 27 west 1320 feet from the east line of the said Robbins D.L.C.; thence north 221 feet; thence east 104 feet; thence north 174 feet, more or less, to intersection with the south line of a tract of land conveyed to Duane B. Berry and Michael N. Rike by deed dated June 14, 1968, and recorded at Page 175 of Book 59 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County; thence east 240 feet, more or less, to an angle corner of said tract conveyed to Duane B. Berry and Michael N. Rike; thence south to intersection with the northerly right of way line of Primary State Highway No. 8; thence following said northerly right of way northwesterly to intersection with the south line of said Sec. 27; thence to the point of beginning;

EXCEPT that portion thereof conveyed to the State of Washington for highway purposes by deed dated February 1, 1955, and recorded at Page 238 of Book 39 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County;

AND EXCEPT that portion thereof conveyed to Pearl Rampley Clay by deed dated September 15, 1956, and recorded October 24, 1956, at Page 367 of Book 42 of Deeds, under Auditor's File No. 51333, Records of Skamania County;

AND EXCEPT that portion thereof conveyed to Daniel and Hazel Danielson, by deeds dated March 25, 1964, and recorded at Pages 388 and 389 of Book 52 of Deeds, under Auditor's File Nos. 62999 and 63000, Records of Skamania County;

AND EXCEPT that portion thereof conveyed to Floyd C. and Dorothy R. Davis, by deed dated October 17, 1969 and recorded November 14, 1969, at Page 336 of Book 61 of Deeds, under Auditor's File No. 71620, Skamania County;

AND a tract of land containing 1.71 acres, more or less, being a part of Lots 8 and 9 of Home Valley, according to the recorded plat thereof, dated April 7, 1902, described as follows:

commencing at a point that is Highway Engineers Station 362+26.3; thence north 23°25' east 50 feet and the true point of beginning; thence continuing north 23°29' east 249.8 feet; thence south 66°31' east 239.6 feet to the east line of said Lot 8; thence south 1°52' east, along the said east line, 276.5 feet to the northerly right of way line of Primary State Highway No. 8, Stevenson to Underwood; thence westerly along the said northerly right of way line 358 feet to the point of beginning; being within Sec. 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.

Diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than .125 (1/8) inch. Water approach velocity to the screen shall be less than 1 foot per second and approaching 0.5 foot per second, as measured one foot in front of the screen.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Issuance of this certificate was based on sufficient waters available at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the certificate holder that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or interests therein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment or bonus of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
