That portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the quarter corner on the west line of the said Sec. 25; thence south 825 feet, thence east 429 feet; thence north 825 feet; thence west 429 feet to the point of beginning;

AND the east 1085 feet of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 26, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.; EXCEPT the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 26; AND EXCEPT the following:

a tract of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 26, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the quarter corner on the east line of the said Sec. 26; thence west along the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 859.80 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence south 12°40' east 566.69 feet; thence south 78°47' west 356.27 feet to the west line of a tract of land conveyed to I. J. Maddux by deed dated January 6, 1947, and recorded at Page 270 of Book 31 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County; thence north 622.20 feet to the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 26; thence east 225.20 feet to the initial point.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Issuance of this certificate was based on sufficient waters available, at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the certificate holder that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

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
