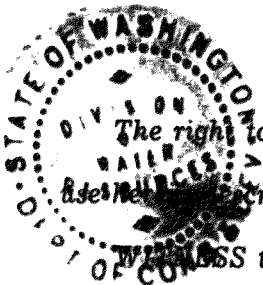
CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that KENNETH G. & DORIS M. FOSTER
of North Bonneville, State of Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
of the waters of Columbia River, ~~contributing to~~
with point or points of diversion within the S. M. Hamilton D.L.C. of Sec. 29; Gov't. Lot 1 of
Sec. 29; Gov't. Lots 5 and 6 of Sec. 30; and E. C. Hardy D.L.C. of
Sec. 30, Twp. 2 N., R. 7 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
appropriation Permit No. 13032 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
record in Volume 19, at Page 9058, on the 6th day of May, 19 64;
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is February 18, 1963; that the
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.75 cubic feet per second, 350 acre-feet per
year, for the irrigation of 175 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

All that portion of the Samuel and Mary Jane Hamilton D.L.C. designated as Claim No. 40,
being parts of Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30 in T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M. lying on the southerly
side of Primary Highway No. 8. ALSO the Samuel M. Hamilton Homestead being Lots 1, 5
and 6 of Sec. 29, and Lots 5 and 6 of Sec. 30, T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M. ALSO all lands commonly
designated as shorelands fronting and joining the premises above described. ALSO THAT
portion of the Johnson D.L.C. lying and being in Sec. 29, T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M. EXCEPT from
the above parcels of land approximately 20 acres conveyed to Warren Packing Company dated
February 26, 1925, and recorded at page 268, Book "U" of Deeds, Records of Skamania County,
Washington



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
