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Bolin Lumber Co. to Standard Box & Lumber Co.

Knew all men by these Presents, that the Bolin Lumber Company, a corporation duly incorporated organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Oregon in consideration of the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20.000) dollars to it paid by Standard Box and Lumber Company, a corporation duly incorporated organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, has bargained and sold, and by these presents hereby does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Standard Box and Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, all the down and standing timber now growing or being upon that certain tract of land situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly known and described as follows to-wit: The Northeast quarter of Section thirty-two (32); the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section thirty-two (32); the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section thirty-four (34); the South half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section thirty-four (34), all in Township two (2) North, Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian. And with the full right and authority to enter upon said lands above described with servants, agents, workmen and employees, and to cut down said timber and trees and to remove the same at any time within the period of five (5) years on and after the 10th day of March 1906; And for that end the grantee herein is granted the full right and authority to construct flumes, roadways, skid-road, railroads or any other means of transportation requisite necessary or convenient to convey and transfer the said timber when felled, or the products thereof from and off the said land. To Have and to Hold the above described premises unto the said Standard Box and Lumber Company, its successors and assigns forever; And the said grantor does covenant to and with the said grantee herein, its successors and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances created or permitted by it, and that it has a good right to make the grant herein and hereby made, and that it will warrant and defend the title thereto and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, claiming by, from, through or under it.
