hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a curve to the right, with a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet, one thousand six hundred and eight and three tenthfeet; thence on a spiral to the right one hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a tangent to said curve one thousand and ninety nine feet; thence on a spiral to the left one hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a curve to the left with a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet, two thousand one hundred and ninety one and seven tenths feet; thence on a spiral to the left one hundred and sixty eight fee; thence on a tangent to said curve one thousand four hundred and ninety eight and six tenth feet to a point on the west line ofsection twenty one; township two north, range aseven east W.M., said point being two thousand three hu dred and sixty five feet and six tenths feet south of the northwest corner of said section twenty one, thence on said last course produced five hundred and thirty feet more or less, to the west line of the Bishop donation land claim, known as claim No. 39, - said center line above described being plainly marked upon the ground by stakes consecutivly numbered and divided, according to the custom of railroad surveys, into divisions of one hundred feett each and decimals tereof, except that the distance from station numbered II3 of said line to station numbered II4 is II9.I feet, and from station I4I to station numbered I42 is 47.8 feet, and from station numbered 193 to station numbered 195 is II4.5 feet, the numbering of said stations commencing with station numbered 4 plus 40, at the point of beginning above described and continuing to station 315 plus 10 being the point of the line above described.
