KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That George W. Brock, of Clarke County, State of Washington, and S.S. Hayes, (Seth S. Hayes) of Portland, Oregon, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Sixty Two and 55/100 Dollars, to them in hand paid by Louis P. Maguy, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto the said party of the second part, the following indenture of mortgage, to wit: that certain mortgage executed on the 17th day of April, A.D.1909, by W.F. Cash and Lettie B. Cash, husband and wife, of Skamania County, Washington, to George W. Brock and S.S.
