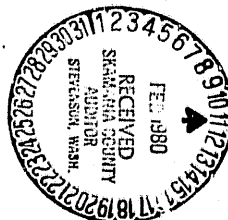
I, TILDA ENGLIV WELLMAN, residing in the County of Clark,

by make, declare and publish this to be my Last Will and Testament:

to serve as Executor of my estate, to serve as such without bond and
to settle my estate without the intervention of any court or courts.
Should my husband fail for any reason to act as Executor, then in that
event, I appoint my daughter, THELMA MARIE LARSON, to act as Executrix
of my estate, to serve as such without bond and to settle my estate
without the intervention of any court or courts.

THIRD: I am a married woman and my husband is
WELDON BRYAN WELLMAN. We have three children as issue of our marriage,
namely, THELMA MARIE LARSON, RAYMOND LEROY WELLMAN and LOUIS LAMONT
WELLMAN; and to the aforementioned and to all other persons whomso-
ever, I give, devise and bequeath nothing except as hereinafter
provided.

FOURTH: If my husband, WELDON BRYAN WELLMAN, survives
me, I give, devise and bequeath to him all of my property, whether
such property be real, personal or mixed, of whatsoever kind or char-
acter and wheresoever located or situated.



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FIFTH: If my husband, WELDON BRYAN WELLMAN, fails to survive me, all of my property, whether such property be real, personal or mixed, of whatsoever kind or character and wheresoever located or situated, shall be divided into three equal shares and one share shall be given, devised and bequeathed to my daughter, THELMA MARIE LARSON; one share shall be given, devised and bequeathed to my son, RAYMOND LEROY WELLMAN; and one share shall be given, devised and bequeathed to my son, LOUIS LAMONT WELLMAN; share and share alike.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, TILDA ENGLIV WELLMAN, do hereunto set my hand and seal this 31 day of January, 1964.
