Know all men by these presents that P.C.Hill of Washougal Wash. of lawful age, in consideration of Fifty dollars to P.C.Hill paid by F.M.Quinn of Washougal Wash. do hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said F.M.Quinn and unto his heirs and assigns, all his right title and interest in and to all that parcel of mines situate in Bald Mountain Mining District County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The Bull Frog Mining claim located by said P.C.Hill on Jan. 1st 1906, in above said mining district described as follows: Beginning at Discovery shaft running in a southerly direction 300 feet easterly to S.E. corner post No. 1, thence 1500 feet southerly to S.E. Cor. Post No. 2, thence 300 feet westerly to center end stake, thence 30 feet more in same direction to S.W. cor. Post No. 3, thence 1500 feet northerly to N.W. cor. Post No. 4, thence 300 feet to place of beginning, old claim formerly known as the Excelsior old claim entered C.J. Moor on a riffle on Blue Jacket creek. Also the Leesley Mining claim located by said P.C.Hill on 27th day of Dec. 1906 in above mining district, commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the S.E.
