The following recommendations are made by the Department of Ecology:

a. Installation of a stream flow measuring gage by the applicant upstream from the reservoir.

b. The minimum flow of Trout Creek downstream from the dam shall be established at the following schedule:

December through June	25 cubic feet per second
July through September	Minimum flow of Trout Creek as measured at the upstream gage. Flows in excess of 8 cubic feet per second may be stored in the reservoir
October and November	10 cubic feet per second

c. At low flow stages all flows according to the above schedule shall be passed through the fishway, but shall not exceed its design capacity.

These minimum flows have been tentatively established from recommendations of the Department of Fisheries and Game and not by existing statutory procedures. Therefore at such time as minimum flows are established on this stream in accordance with Chapter 90.22 RCW, this certificate shall be conditioned to the extent of the new setting, providing that, under not conditions shall the certificate holder be subject to a low flow requirement more restrictive than that specified above.


The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Favorable consideration of this application has been based on sufficient waters available, at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the applicant that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in R/CW 90.14.100.
