The following is a description of the land, real estate, and premises hereby appropriated to the use of petitioner:

A strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of petitioner's railway, as the same is now located and staked out and as said center line is hereinafter described, over and across Lot four of section 34, in township 3 north, of range 9 east of the Willamette Meridian; said center line being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the line between sections 34 and 35, said township and range, said point being forty-four and one tenth feet south of the corner to sections 26, 27, 24, and 25, said township and range; thence in a northwesterly direction on a curve to the left, having a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet,-- tangent to said curve making an angle of 97° with said section line,-- a distance of one thousand three hundred and fifteen feet, more or less, to the west line of said lot four.
