Know all men by these presents that Rudolf Goldt and Martha Goldt the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred thirty five (\$535.00) dollars gold coin of the United States to them in hand paid by Eli Vaughan, the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold assigned and transferred and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell assign transfer and set over to said party of the second part a certain Indenture of mortgage bearing date the 20th day of August 1910 made and executed by John Giese and Amelia T. Giese to the said parties of the first part to secure the payment of the sum of five hundred thirty five dollars together with the note therein described and the money due or to grow due thereon with the interest which said mortgage was recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Skamania County Washington in Book I of mortgages page 405 on the 25th day of August 1910.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part that they are the lawful owners and holders of said note and mortgage and that they have a good right to sell and assign the same as aforesaid and that there is now due and owing upon said note and mortgage the sum of five hundred thirty five (\$535.00) dollars with interest from the 27th day of March 1911.
