Beginning at a point 214.5 feet north of the Southwest corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 3 N., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.W.M., thence east 1320 feet; thence south 1320 feet; thence west 1320 feet; thence north 1320 feet to the true point of beginning.
