Inman to Wills

This Indenture witnesseth that we P.F.Inman and Mary Jane Inman his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred seventy five (\$275.00) dollars to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the said P.S.C.Wills his heirs and assign the following described premises to-wit:

The south fifty (50) feet off of Lot eight (8) and all of Lot nine (9) in Block one (1) of Roselawn addition to the town of Stevenson as show by fccial plat of said addition now on file and of record in the office of the Auditor for Skamania Co. Wash. Grantors agree to insure the buldings to be erected on said rpremises said insurance in case of fire to be used to re-built said buildings or to be paid to grantee herein. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtances thereunto bologing or in anywsie apertaining unto the said P.S.C.Wills his heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred seventy five (\$275.00) dollars with i terest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to-wit:

On or before two years after date for value received we promise to pay to the order of P S.C.Wills two hundred seventy five (\$275.00) dollars with interest thereon payable semi-annually at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from date; and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note. If the interest is not paid when due, it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest, principal and interest payable in .S. Gold coin. And in case sht is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof we promise to pay such additional sum as the court may
