Beginning for the description of the Index No.5 lode claim, at corner No.1, identical with corner No.2 of said Index No.4 lode claim, from which the quarter corner between said sections seventeen and eighteen bears north thirty-nine degrees and forty-nine minutes east one thousand one hundred and twenty-three and eleven hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, south three degrees and five minutes west three hundred feet to a post from which discovery bears south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east twenty-five feet distant, five hundred and forty-two and three tenths feet to corner No.4 of said Index No.3 lode claim; six hundred feet to corner No.2, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 2-779 and 3-779,

Thence, second course, south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 3-779 and 2-779.

Thence, third course, north three degrees and five minutes east six hundred feet to corner No.4, identical with corner No.3 of said Index No.4 lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument No.4, bears north sixty-four degrees and fifty-five minutes east one thousand three hundred and forty and seventy-one hundredths feet distant.

Thence, fourth course, north eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Index No.5 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Index No.6, lode claim at corner No.1, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked I-779 and 2-779, from which the corner common to said sections seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty bears south fifty-four degrees and thirty-two minutes west eight hundred and eighty-nine and ninety-four hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, north three degrees and five minutes east six hundred feet to corner No.2, identical with corner No.3 of said Index No.5 lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument No.4, bears north forty-six degrees and fifty-three minutes east one thousand seven hundred and seven and ninety-eight hundredths feet distant.

Thence, second course, north eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3 identical with corner No.2 of said Index No.5, lode claim.

Thence, third course, south three degrees and five minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east nine feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 4-779 and 3-779.

Thence, fourth course, south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Index No.6 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Index No.7 lode claim at corner No.1, a fir post six inches square, four feet long, marked I-779 and I-779, from which the corner common to said sections seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty bears north eighty-three degrees and eleven minutes west six hundred and ninety-seven and thirty-eight hundredths feet distant.
