The United States of America, To all whome these presents shall come Greeting: Whereas the Santa Fe Pacific Company being the owner of a tract of land described as follows: The Lots numbered one two three and four of Section five in Township sixteen North of Ramge seven East of Gila and Salt River Meridian in Arizona, containing one hundred and fifty four acres and twenty four hundredths of an acre, situated and included within the limits of a public forest reservation known and designated as the San Francisco Mountain Forest Reserve, in a Arizona, has under the provisions of an act approved June 4th 1897, entitled " An act making appropriations for sundry civila expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending gune thirtieth 1898 and for other purposes, reconveyed and relonquished the said tract to the United States and has, under the said provisions of said act selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of vacant public land now open for settlement, to-wit: The Lots numbered one and two, the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and the Northwest quaretr of the Southeast quarter of Section twenty eight in Township three North of Ra nge seven East of Willamette Meridian in Washington, containing One Hundred and fifty three acres and seventy three hundredhs of an acre Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the aforesaid act, have given and granted, and by these present do give and grant unto the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company and to its successors the lands last above desc ribed: T To have and to hold the same, together with allthe rights, priviliges and immunities and appurter nances thereuto belonging unto the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, and to its successors and assigns forever.
