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Brock to Williams

This Indenture made this 4th dy of October 1911 between Jacob L. Brock and Flora A. Brock his wife, mortgagors, and Sam Williams, Mortgagee, Witnesseth that the said mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee his heirs and assigns forever all the following described real estate situated in the Cou ty of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section eleven (11) Township three (3) North of Range nine (9) East of Willamette Meridian containing 40 acres. Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold unto the said mortgagee his heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of five hundred dollars in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to-wit:

The Dalles Oregon, October 4th 1911

Three years after date without grace I promise to pay to the order of Sam Williams at The Dalles Oregon five hundred dollars in gold coin of the United States of the present standard value with interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum from date until paid for value received. Interest to be paid annually and if not so paid the whole sum of principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof I promise to pay in addition to the costs
