Bueche to Goddard ✓

This Indenture Witnesseth that Fred Bueche and Bertha Bueche his wife for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred (\$600.00) dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof sis hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto Sarah F. Goddard, party of the second part the following described real property to-wit:
The east one half of the west one half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter and the east one half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter Section twenty two (22) Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing thirty (30) acres more or less. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Sarah F. Goddard her heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of six hundred (\$600.00) dollars in accordance with the tenor of a certain instrument of writing of which the following is a copy to-wit:

One year after date without grace we promise to pay to the order of Sarah F. Goddard six hundred dollars in gold coin of the United States of the present standard value with interest thereon in like gold coin at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date until paid for value received. Interest to be paid annually and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted
