This Indenture Witnesseth that we, C.L. Welden and Florence Welden of Skamania Co. Wash. in consideration of the sum of three hundred and no/100 dollars to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto said W.A. Arnold, the following described real premises to-wit: The Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section twenty six (26) in Township three (3) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian excepting one acre therefrom heretofore deeded to J.R. Kee as recorded on page 348 in Book K of deeds. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said W.A. Arnold his heirs and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred (\$300.00) dollars with interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to-wit:
