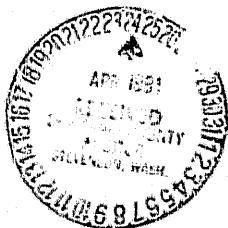

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

A tract of land located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, T. 3 N., R. 7 E.W.M., more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the southeast corner of Sec. 25, thence north 89°47'30" west along the south line of said Sec. 25, 1,543.13 feet to the easterly right of way line of County Road No. 2062 designated as the Kanaka Creek Road as constructed in 1970; thence north 17°27'34" west along said right of way line 377.44 feet; thence north 21°32'34" west 167.48 feet; thence north 25°37'34" west 174.10 feet; thence north 35°58'34" west 268.16 feet; thence north 46°19'34" west 133.77 feet to point of beginning; thence north 40°14'01" east 246.75 feet; thence south 67°27'54" east 345.97 feet; thence south 04°29'04" west 146.02 feet; thence south 17°33'43" west 420.12 feet to the easterly right of way line of said Kanaka Creek Road; thence northerly along said easterly right of way line 603.94 feet to point of beginning; EXCEPT that portion thereof which lies within the 300 foot right of way acquired by the United States of America for the Bonneville Power Administration's No. 1 and No. 2 Bonneville-Coulee transmission lines.



The access port shall be maintained at all times in the well (s).

That portion of this authorization relating to irrigation is classified as a Family Farm Permit in accordance with Chapter 90.66 RCW (Initiative Measure No. 59). This means the land being irrigated under this authorization shall comply with the following definition: Family Farm - a geographic area including not more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands, whether contiguous or noncontiguous, the controlling interest in which is held by a person having a controlling interest in no more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands in the State of Washington which are irrigated under water rights acquired after December 8, 1977. Furthermore, the land being irrigated under this authorization must continue to conform to the definition of a family farm.
