Chesser to Greene

This Indenture made this 25th day of November 1911 between G.C.Chesser and Nannie Chesser husband and wife of Stevenson Washington party of the first part and Albert R.Greene of the same place party of the second part witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred (\$900.00) dollars lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Beginning at a point six hundred sixty (660) feet west of the center of section thirty six (36) in Township three North of Range seven East of Willamette Meridian, running thence south nine hundred forty two (942) feet to the north side of Rock Creek Hot Springs Road, thence along the North side of said road as follows: South 33 deg 50' East 246 feet, thence south 42 deg 10' East 130 feet, thence south 60 deg 25' East 190 feet, thence North 11 deg 19' West 357 feet (this point being 990 feet south of the line running east and west through center of said section 36) thence North 894 feet to the south line of the Gropper road, thence in a northwesterly direction along said southerly line of said Gropper road to the point of beginning containing seven (7) acres more or less. It is understood that the notes mentioned herein may be paid at any time or any part thereof so long as any payment be not less than \$100.00. This slip is attached to and made a part of this mortgage of even date. Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) together with interest thereon in like gold coin at the rate of four (4) per cent per annum from date until paid according to the terms of four (4) certain promissory notes bearing date Nov.25th 1911 made by G.C.Chesser and Nannie Chesser, the mortgagees payable on or before Dec.1st 1912, 1913, 1914 and 1915 to the order of Albert R.Greene, and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof. But in case default shall be made in the payment of the principal or interest according to the terms and conditions thereof, then the said party of the second part or his executors administrators or assigns are hereby authorized to declare all of said sums at once due and payable and empowered
