Now Know Ye, That The United States Of America, In consideration of the premises and in conformity with the aforesaid act have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Aztec Land and Cattle Company Limited and to its successors the land a last above described: To have and to hold the same, unto the said Aztec Land and Cattle Company Limited, and to its successors and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.

In Testimony Thereof, I, Theodobe Roosevelt President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty-ninth.
