place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said America No.4 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Sweden No.1 lode claim at corner No.1, a larch post six inches square, four feet-long, marked 1-781 A. and 4-620 in mound of stone, identical with corner No.4 of said Denmark Discovery lode claim, from which the corner to said townships nine and ten bears south forty-six degrees and nine minutes west two hundred and forty-nine and seven tenths feet distant. Thence, first course, south one degree and thirty-two minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 2-781 A and 4-781 A. Thence, second course, north eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bærs north one degree and thirty-two minutes west six and five tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.3, identical with corner No.2 of said America No.3 lode claim. Thence, first course, north eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes east six hundred feet to corner No.2, identical with corner No.1 of said America No.4 lode claim. Thence, second course, north one degree and thirty-two minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, identical with corner No.2 of said America No.3 lode claim. Thence, third course, south eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south one degree and thirty-two minutes east ten and five tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.4, identical with corner No.2 of said Sweden No.1 lode claim. Thence, fourth course, south one degree and thirty two minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Sweden No.2 vein or lods.

Beginning for the description of the Viola Second lode claim at corner No.1 a larch post four inches square marked 1-781 A. and 2-781 A., in mound of stone from which said U.S. location monument No.1 hears north seventy-three degrees and fifty-three minutes east six hundred and twenty-five and eighteen hundredths feet distant, and the corner to said townships nine and ten bears south three degrees and twenty-one minutes west two thousand one hundred and sixty-eight and fifty-seven hundredths feet distant. Thence, first course, north six degrees and twenty-six minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2, a larch post four inches square marked 2-781 A. Thence, second course, south eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes west six hundred feet to corner No.3, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 3-781 A and 2-781 A. Thence, third course south six degrees and twenty-six minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.4, a cedar post six inches square, four feet long, marked 4-781 A; 3-781 A; 2-781 A and 1-781 A. in mound of stone. Thence, fourth course, north eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears north six degrees and twenty-six minutes west five feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Viola Second vein or lode.
