Thence, eighth course, north thirty-one degrees and thirty-five minutes east three hundred and forty feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Cena vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Lakeside lode claim at corner No.1, identical with corner No.4 of said Mabel lode claim, from which the east quarter corner of said section one bears south fifty degrees and six minutes east four hundred and seventy-four and eighty-nine hundredths feet distant. Thence, first course, south eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes west six hundred feet to corner No.2, identical with corner No.4 of said Ada lode claim. Thence, second course, south twenty-seven degrees and forty-four minutes east four hundred and eighty-three and nine tenths feet to corner No.3, on lake shore, a cedar post six inches square, four feet long, marked 3-781 A. Thence, third course, south fifty-three degrees and twenty-seven minutes east three hundred and sixty-one and five tenths feet to corner No.4 a fir stump twenty inches in diameter, thirty inches above ground marked 4-781 A. Thence, fourth course, south twenty-seven degrees and twenty-one minutes west, on meander of shore line of lake, along perpendicular rock bluff, three hundred and forty and two tenths feet to point on log and not established.

Thence, south eighteen degrees and forty-seven minutes west five hundred and eighty-one and one tenth feet to corner No.5, not established. Thence, fifth course, north eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes east fifty-five and fourteen hundredths feet to witness corner to said corner No.5 a cedar tree six inches in diameter, cut off three feet above ground, marked W.C. 5-781 A. and W.C. 3-781 ; one hundred and sixty-seven and ninety-four hundredths feet to a point from which discovery post bears north one degree and thirty-two minutes west six feet distant; four hundred and sixty-seven and ninety-four hundredths feet to corner No.6, a hemlock post six inches square, four feet long, marked 6-781 A and 3-781 A, from which said U.S. location monument No.7, bears south eighteen degrees and twenty-nine minutes west two thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven and five tenths feet distant. Thence, sixth course, north one degree and thirty-two minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Lakeside vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl lode claim at corner No.1, identical with corner No.1 of said Mabel lode claim, from which the east quarter corner of said section one bears south thirty-six degrees and seventeen minutes west three hundred and ninety seven and eighty-two hundredths feet distant. Thence first course, south eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes west six hundred feet to corner No.2, identical with corner No.4 of said Mabel lode claim. Thence, second course, south one degree and thirty-two minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, identical with corner No.6 of said Lakeside lode claim. Thence, third course, north eighty-eight degrees and twenty-eight minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears north one degree and thirty-two minutes west ten and three tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 4-781 A. Thence, fourth course, north one degree and thirty-two minutes west one thousand and seven and four tenths feet to corner No.1 of said Sweden No.2 lode claim; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl vein or lode.>

Beginning for the description of the Hillside lode claim at corner No.1, a fir post six inches square, four feet long, marked 1-781 A from which said U.S. location monument No.7
