KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That whereas the Aztec Land and Cattle Company, Limited, (a corporation) organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, was, on the eleventh day of June, 1906, the owner of the following described land, towit:
