Thence, second course, north eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, identical with corner No.4 of said Index No.6 lode claim.

Thence, third course, south three degrees and five minutes west three hundred feet to a poit from which discovery bears south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes wast twenty feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 4-779 and 2-779.

Thence, fourth course, south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east one onerthousand five hundred feet to corner No.I, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Index No.7 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Index No.8 lode claim at corner No.I, identical with corner No.I of said Index No.7 lode claim.

Thence, first course, north eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2, identical with corner No.4 of said Index No.7 lode claim.

Thence, second course, south three degrees and five minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south thirty degrees east fifteen feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.3, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 3-779.

Thence, third course, south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 4-779 and I-779.

Thence fourth course, north three degrees and five minutes east six hundred feet to corner No.I, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Index No.8 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Index No.9 lode claim at corner No.I, identical with corner No.4 of said Index No.8 lode claim from which the corner common to said sections seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty bears north fourty-four degrees and four minutes west nine hundred and fourty-nine and one hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, south eighty-six degrees and fifty-five minutes east six hundred feet to corner No.2, a fir post six inches square, four feet long, marked 2-779 and 3-779.

Thence, second course, north three degrees and five minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, a fir post six inches square, four feet long, marked 3-779 and 2-779 from which said U.S. location monument No.4 bears north twenty-three degrees and fifty-two minutes east one thousand six hundred and thirty-nine and forty-eight hundredths feet distant.

Thence, third course, north eighty-six degrees and fifty-minutes west three hundred## feet to a point from which discovery post bears south three degrees and five minutes west thirty feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post six inches square, four feet long, marked 2-779 and 4-779.

Thence, fourth course, south three degrees and five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.I, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in leng#th along said Index No.9 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Index No.IO lode claim at corner No.I, not established, from which the quarter corner between said sections seventeen and eighteen bears nortg sixty-seven degrees west eight hundred and eighty and seventy-four hundredths feet distant.
