THIS INDENTURE, Made this First day of July, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven, between Peter S.C.Wills, unmarried, of Stevenson, Skamania County, State of Washington, and Frank Melvin and Anna M. Melvin, his wife, of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, parties of the first part, and W.C. Slattery, of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, assigns and executors forever, all the fir timber lying, standing or being upon that certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, described as follows, to-wit:
