All tide and shore lands of the second class, owned by the State of Washington, situate in front of, adjacent to or upon that portion of the government meander line lying in front of the following described upland: In front of Lot 1/section 32 township 3 north range 9 east of the Willamette Meridian, with a total frontage of 20.31 lineal chains, more or less, measured along the Government meander line according to a certified copy of the government field notes of the survey thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.
