LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

A tract of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, T. 3 N., R. 5 E.W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of a traveled road, which point is 5,331.41 feet south 76°03'48" east of the northwest corner of said Sec. 29; thence along the center of said roadway south 1°29'55" east 25 feet, south 59°30'25" west 182.21 feet, south 26°15'45" west 400.89 feet, south 47°25'45" west 194.07 feet and south 05°32'34" east 25.09 feet; thence west 1,842.74 feet; thence north 633.22 feet; thence east 2,316.98 feet to the point of beginning; said tract containing 30 acres, more or less.



Diversion intake shall be rightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than 0.125 (1/8) inch. Water approach velocity to the screen shall be less than 1 foot per second and approaching 0.5 foot per second, as measured one foot in front of the screen.
