

## Aalvik to Bank

Know all men by these presents that we, Christian Aalvik and Anna Aalvik (his wife) of Minneapolis, Minn., the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and no/100 dollars lawful money of the United States of America to us in hand paid by Bank of Stevenson a corporation, of Stevenson Washington, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell assign transfer and set over unto said party of the second part a certain Indenture of mortgage bearing date the 14th day of August 1911 made and executed by Ed Canoose and Mary Canoose his wife of Stevenson Washington to Christian Aalvik, to secure the payment of six hundred and no/100 dollars with interest thereon at eight per cent per annum from date until paid and recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County Washington in Book K of mortgages at page 249 on the 15th day of August 1911; together with the promissory note therein described and the money due and to become due thereon with interest. And the said parties of the first part do hereby make constitute and appoint the said party of the second part their true and lawful attorney, irrevocable in their name or otherwise but at the proper cost and charges of said party of the second part to have use and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of said money and interest and in case of payment to discharge the same as fully as the said party of the first part might or could do if these presents were not made.
