

Ezra Rust to Wm.N.Brown

This Indenture Made the 30th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seven (1907) Between Ezra Rust and Emma B. Rust his wife of New York City, New York, of the first part and William N. Brown of Ann Arbor, Michigan, of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to them in hand paid by the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece or parcel of land situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, known and described as follows:

The Southeast quarter of Section five in Township two North Range six East of Willamette Meridian (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 5 Town 2 N. R. 6 E.). Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining; To Have and to Hold the said lands to the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever.
