

recorded in book I of deeds at page 289, records of Skamania County, Washington, on December 2, 1905. The center line last above referred to is particularly described as follows to- wit: Commencing on the section line between sections thirty-one and thirty-two of said township and range at a point six hundred and eighty seven and eight tenths feet south of the corner to sections twenty nine, thirty, thirty one and thirty two, on a curve to the left, with a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet the tangent of said curve making an angle with the section line of 43 deg. 16'; running thence northeasterly 15 feet to the end of a spiral curve to the left; thence along said spiral curve one hundred and sixty eight feet to the end of said spiral curve; thence on a tangent to said curve a distance of three hundred and sixteen and eight tenths feet to the beginning of a spiral curve to the right; thence along said spiral curve two hundred feet; thence along a curve to the right with a radius of two thousand two hundred and ninety two feet, one thousand one hundred and eighty two feet to the end of said curve; thence along a spiral to said curve two hundred feet; thence on a tangent to said curve one thousand four hundred and thirty and four tenth feet to the spiral of a curve to the left; thence on said spiral curve one hundred and sixty eight feet to the beginning of a curve to the left/with a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet; thence along said curve seven hundred and ninety feet more or less to the west line of said lot three; thence along said curve continued one hundred and sixty and seven tenths feet; thence on a spiral to said curve one hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a tangent to said curve two hundred and sixty and eight tenths feet; thence on a spiral of a curve to the right one hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a curve to the right, having a radius of two thousand eight hundred and sixty five feet, seven hundred and twenty feet, more or less, to the east line of lot four of said section, township and range.

The spiral curves above mentioned are those known as Searles' Railroad Spirals.
