

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Harold E. Mahieu, a legal resident of Oak Harbor, WA, now in the active military service as a AT1, USN, SSAN: [REDACTED], in the service of the United States and stationed at NAMTD, NAS Whidbey Island, WA, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint my wife, Sally L. Mahieu, whose present address is 1358 Western Drive, Oak Harbor, WA, my true and lawful attorney act as follows, that is to say:

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power:

1. DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY - To sell, assign, transfer, convey, exchange, deed, mortgage, pledge, lease, let, license, demise, remise, quit-claim, bargain or otherwise dispose of any or all of my real estate, stocks, bonds, evidences of indebtedness and other securities and other personal tangible and intangible or mixed property, or any custody, possession, interest or right therein at public or private sale, upon such terms, consideration, and conditions as my said attorney shall deem advisable and to execute, acknowledge and deliver such instruments and writing of whatsoever kind and nature as may be necessary, convenient or proper in the premises.

2. COLLECTION OF DEBTS - To demand, collect, recover, sue for, receive and give receipt or release for any moneys, debts, dividends, interests, royalties, legacies, annuities, demands, discounts, income, rents, profits, securities or other property of any sort, now or hereafter due or becoming due to me or to which I may be or hereafter become entitled.

3. INDORSEMENTS -

- a) To indorse and negotiate for any and all purpose all promissory notes, bills of exchange, checks, drafts or other negotiable or non-negotiable paper payable to me or to my order;
- b) To indorse for transfer all certificates of stock, bond, or other securities;
- c) To indorse and cash United States Savings Bonds and notes.

4. EXECUTING GOVERNMENT VOUCHERS - To execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances, compensation, and reimbursements properly payable to me by the Government of the United States or any agency or department thereof, including, but not restricted to, allowances and reimbursements for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and regulations.

5. DEPOSITING MONEY AND OTHER PROPERTY - To deposit in my attorney's or my name, or jointly in both our names, in any banking institution, funds or property, and to withdraw any part or all of my deposits at any time made by me in my behalf.

6. BORROWING MONEY - To borrow money in my name when deemed necessary to my said attorney upon such terms as to my said attorney appear proper and to execute such instruments as may be requisite for such purpose.

7. ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY - To buy, receive, lease, accept or otherwise acquire in my name and for my account property, real, personal, or mixed, upon such terms, considerations and conditions as my said attorney shall think proper.

8. RECOVERING POSSESSION OF PROPERTY - To eject, remove, or relieve tenants or other persons from, and recover possession of, any property, real personal or mixed in which I now or hereafter may have an interest.

9. LITIGATION - To institute, maintain, defend, compromise, arbitrate or otherwise dispose of, any and all actions, suits, attachments or other legal proceedings for or against me.

10. TAX RETURNS - To prepare and execute any tax returns, including, but not limited to, Federal income tax returns, State income tax returns, Social Security tax returns, and Federal and State information and estimated returns; to execute any claims for refund, protests, applications for abatement, petitions to the United States Board of Tax Appeals or any other Board or Court, Federal or State, consents and waivers to determination and assessment of taxes that is provided by statute of limitations; to receive and indorse and collect any checks in settlement of any refund of taxes; to examine and to request and receive copies of any tax returns, reports and other information from the United States Treasury Department or any other taxing authority, Federal or State, in connection with any of the foregoing matters.

11. SHIPMENT OF PROPERTY - To take possession and order the removal and shipment of any of my property from or to any post warehouse, depot, dock, or other place of storage or safekeeping, Governmental or private, and to execute and deliver any release, voucher, receipt, shipping ticket, certificate or other instrument necessary or convenient for such purpose.

12. AUTOMOBILES - To execute and deliver to the proper persons and authority any and all documents, instruments and papers necessary to effect proper registration of any automobile in which I now or may hereafter have an interest, or the sale thereof and transfer of legal title thereto as required by law and to collect, and receipt for all moneys paid in consideration of such sale and transfer.

FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid attorney-in-fact to execute, acknowledge and deliver any instrument under seal or otherwise, and to do all things, necessary to carry out the intent, hereof, hereby granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to act in and concerning the premises as fully and effectually as I may do if personally present.

PROVIDED, however, that all business transacted hereunder for me or for my account shall be transacted in my name, and that all indorsements and instruments executed by my said attorney for the purpose of carrying out the foregoing powers shall contain my name, followed by that of my said attorney and the designation "attorney-in-fact."

I further declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding on myself and my heirs, legal and personal representatives and assigns, whether the same shall have done either before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said attorney; and whether or not I, the grantor of this instrument, shall have been reported or listed, either officially or otherwise, as "missing in action" as that phrase is used in military parlance, or as "captured," it being the intentment hereof that such status designation shall not bar my attorney from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted, and that such report of "missing in action" or "captured" shall neither constitute nor be interpreted as constituting notice of my death nor operate to revoke this instrument.

FURTHER, unless sooner revoked or terminated by me, this Power of Attorney shall become, NULL, and VOID from and after 1 June, 19 84.

Notwithstanding my insertion of a specific expiration date herein, if on the above specified expiration date, or if on the above specified expiration date, or if at any time within the thirty (30) days immediately proceeding that specified expiration date, I should be, or have been, carried in a military status of "missing", "missing-in-action" or "prisoner-of-war", then this power of attorney shall automatically continue to remain valid and in full effect until sixty (60) days after I have returned to the United States military control following termination of such "missing-in-action" or "prisoner-of-war" status.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by the disability of this principal.

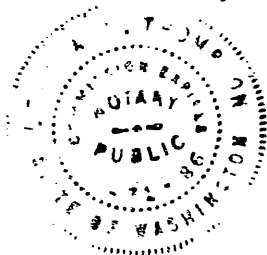
