Beginning at the southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Sec. 36; thence along the east line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Sec. 36 north 804 feet; thence south 55°17' west to the center of Nelson Creek; thence in a southerly direction following the center of Nelson Creek to the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Sec. 36; thence east to the point of beginning.

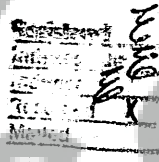
PROVISIONS.

That portion of this authorization relating to irrigation is classified as a Family Farm Permit in accordance with Chapter 90.66 RCW (Initiative Measure No. 59). This means the land being irrigated under this authorization shall comply with the following definition: Family Farm - a geographic area including not more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands, whether contiguous or noncontiguous, the controlling interest in which is held by a person having a controlling interest in no more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands in the State of Washington which are irrigated under water rights acquired after December 8, 1977. Furthermore, the land being irrigated under this authorization must continue to conform to the definition of a family farm.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Issuance of this certificate was based on sufficient waters available, at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the certificate holder that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

Diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than 0.125 (1/8) inch. Water approach velocity to the screen shall be less than 1 foot per second and approaching 0.5 foot per second, as measured one foot in front of the screen.
