This Indenture made this 9th day of April 1912 between E.M.Shields and Cina B.Shields husband and wife, the parties of the first part and A.C.Sly and James H.Sly, parties of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred thirty-eight and 75/100 dollars gold coin of the United States to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

A strip of land one hundred and fifty feet (150) in width off the north side of Lot numbered one (1) in Stevenson Park Addition according to the recorded plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County Washington excepting a strip of land on the easterly end of said strip fifteen feet in width for a road. Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of three hundred and thirty eight and 75/100 dollars gold coin of the United States together with interest in like gold coin at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date until paid, according to the tenor of two (2) certain promissory notes bearing even date made by the mortgagors payable on or before Jan. 1st 1913 and Jan. 1st 1914 respectively to the order of the mortgagees, and these presents shall be void of such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof. But in case default shall be made in the payment of the principal or interest of said promissory notes or any part thereof when the same shall become due and payable, according to the terms and conditions thereof then the said parties of the second part their executors administrators and assigns are hereby authorized to declare all of said sums at once
