

to a release of the mortgage or deed of trust aforesaid;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar paid to the said parties of the first part by the said parties of the second part, the said parties of the first part do hereby remise, release, convey and quitclaim unto the said parties of the second part, respectively, the property, rights, privileges, easements, liens, claims and demands of every kind and character of said respective parties described in and conveyed, transferred, mortgaged and assigned, or intended so to be, by the said mortgage or deed of trust aforesaid, (reference being hereby made to said mortgage or deed of trust for fuller description of the property covered thereby), together with all the appendages, appurtenances, privileges, reversions and remainders thereof, and all of the right, title, interest, claims and demands whatsoever as well at equity as in law, which the said parties of the first part had or acquired in, by or through the aforesaid mortgage or deed of trust and freed and discharged from the lien thereof.

It being the intention and it is hereby expressly declared that this instrument shall operate as a full release and discharge of the said mortgage deed of trust of January 30, A.D.1911, and to completely restore to and re-vest in the parties of the second part severally and respectively, all of their respective property rights, interests, rights, privileges, easements, liens, claims and demands freed from the liens of said mortgage deed of trust and from all claims and demands thereunder and under any and all contracts, agreements or undertakings supplementary or collateral.

And the county auditor of Skamania County, in the State of Washington, is hereby authorized and directed to discharge said mortgage or deed of trust upon the records of his office by appropriate marginal memoranda according to the statute in such case made and provided.
