

## Union Trust Co. to Blazier Timber Co. et al.

This Indenture made this 22nd day of April A.D.1912 by and between the Union Trust Company a corporation having its principal place of business in the city of Detroit Michigan, party of the first part, and the Blazier Timber Company (an Oregon corporation having its principal office in the city of Portland, Oregon, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

Whereas the said party of the first part was duly appointed co-trustee under that certain mortgage or deed of trust dated January 30th 1911 executed by the Blazier Timber Company, Oregon Washington Timber Company, Washington Northern Railroad Company and J.E. Blazier, to the Mississippi Valley Trust Company (a Missouri corporation having its principal office and place of business in the City of St. Louis, Missouri) which mortgage or deed of trust has been recorded in the office of the County Auditor for Skamania County Washington in Book K of Mortgages at pages 139-160; and Whereas under date of January 26th 1912 the said Blazier Timber Company executed and delivered to the said Mississippi Valley Trust Company a confirmatory mortgage or deed of trust covering certain timber lands therein described and acquired by said Blazier Timber Company subsequent to the execution and delivery of the aforesaid mortgage or deed of trust dated January 30th 1911 which confirmatory mortgage was made for the purpose of bringing all of said described and after acquired property within and subject to all of the terms and provisions of said mortgage or trust of deed of January 30th 1911 and which said confirmatory mortgage or deed of trust has been recorded in the office of the Auditor for Skamania County Washington in Book K of mortgages at page 402, and

Whereas under and by virtue of a certain indenture dated April 12th 1912 executed by the Mississippi Valley Trust Company, and the said Union Trust Company, Co-Trustee, to the said Blazier Timber Company, Oregon Washington Timber Company and Washington Northern Railroad Company and J.E. Blazier, said mortgage or deed of trust of January 30th 1911 was released, and all property described therein and covered thereby, remised, released, conveyed and quitclaimed to the said Blazier Timber Company, Oregon Washington Timber Company, Washington Northern Railroad Company and J.E. Blazier severally and respectively, and Whereas under and by virtue of a certain Indenture date April 12th 1912 execute by the said Mississippi Valley Trust Company to the said Blazier Timber Company said confirmatory mortgage of January 26th 1912 was duly released and all the property therein described and covered by, remises, released conveyed and quitclaimed unto said Blazier Timber Company:

Now Therefore in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar paid to the said party of the first part by the said party of the second part, the said party of the first part does hereby remise, release convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part all of the property, rights, privileges easements claims and demands of every kind and description which said party of the first part acquired or might have acquired under and by virtue of the aforesaid confirmatory mortgage of January 26th 1912.

In Witness whereof the said Union Trust Company, party of the first part has caused this Indenture to be signed in its behalf and in its name by its President and its corporate seal to be hereto affixed and attested by its secretary all as to the day and year first above written.
