This Indenture witnesseth that I Helen S.Gray a single woman of Portland, Oregon
in consideration of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents bargain, sell and
convey unto E.P.Ash of Stevenson, Washington the following described premises to-wit:
Lots nine, ten, thirteen and fourteen of section thirteen Township three North of Range
seven and one half East of the Willamette Meridian containing 153.01 acres. Together
with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appur-
taining, to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said E.P.Ash and
his heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the
payment of the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and interest thereon in accordance
with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to-wit:

On or before one year after date for value received I promise to pay to the order of
E.P.Ash five hundred (\$500.00) dollars with interest thereon payable at maturity at
the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both
principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the
holder of this note. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with
the principal and bear like interest principal and interest payable in lawful money
of the United States. And in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any
portion thereof I promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable
as attorneys fees to be taxed as part of the costs of such suit for the use of plaintiff's
attorney. It is specially agreed and consented to that a deficiency judgment may be
taken in a suit upon this note.
