thence continuing on same curve to the left one thousand and five feet; thence on a spiral to said curve one hundred and sixty eight feet; thence on a tangent to said curve five hundred twenty six and seven tenths feet; thence on a spiral curve to the right two hundred and twenty eight feet; themce on a curve to the right, having a radius of nineteen hundred and ten feet, nineteen hundred eighty three and three tenths feet; thence on a spiral curve to the right two hundred and twenty eight feet; thence on a tangent to said curve sixhundred and sixty four feet to the beginning of a spiral curve to the left; thence on said spiral curve to the left two hundred feet to the beginning of a curve to the left having a radius of twenty two hundred and ninety two feet; thence on said curve to the left a distance of ten hundred and forty feet, more or less, to the west line of the James M. Findley donation land claim in section thirty six township three north range eight east Willamette Meridian. The spiral curves above referred to are Searles' railroad spirals.

It is furthe Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed that the appropriation of said premises and the interest therein hereby vested in said petitioner, shall, at all times after the expiration of the lease of said premises now held by the claimants C.T.Belcher and Jennie T.Belcher his wife, be subject to the right of said Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company to contuct water from that certain spring now on said premises, which has been boxed, in such a manner as not to interfer with the construction, maintenance or operation of petitioners railway; and further subject to the right of said claimant in the same manner, to conduct sewerage pipes across said premises and underneath the track of said petitioners said railway, from the north side of said premises to the south side thereof; and further subject to the right of said claimants tomaintain a wire for the transmission of electric light across said premises. supported in a sfe and secure manner and maintained subject to reasonable rules and regulations of petitioner, so as not to interfer with the maintenance or operation of said railway.
