

to the right two hundred and twenty eight feet; thence on a curve to the right, with a radius of one thousand nine hundred and ten feet, one hundred and sixty five feet, more or less, to the east line of said lot one.

A strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of petitioners railway, as the same is now located and staked out and in course of construction over and across lot three of section twenty, township I north of range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian, which center line is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing on the section line between sections 19 and twenty, said township and range, at a point one thousand five hundred and fifty three and three tenths feet south of the corner to sections 17, 18, 19 and 20 of said township and range, - the west tangent of a curve making an angle with said section line of $93^{\circ}20'5''$; running from said point on a curve to the left, with a radius of five thousand seven hundred and thirty feet, five hundred and twenty seven feet; thence on a tangent to said curve northeasterly two thousand and sixty four feet, more or less; to the west line of said lot three; thence continuing along said last course produced one thousand one hundred and sixty one feet; thence on a spiral of a curve to the left two hundred and twenty eight feet; thence along a curve to the left, having a radius of one thousand and nine hundred and ten feet, eight hundred feet more or less, to the north line of said lot three.

A strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of petitioners railway as the same is now located, staked out and in course of construction over and across that portion of the Robbins Donation Land Claim in section thirty five, township three north, of range 8 east of the Willamette meridian, which center line is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of section thirty five township 3 north range 8 east, said point being six hundred and thirty seven and six tenths feet south of the northwest corner of said section 35; thence southeasterly on a tangent at an angle of $64^{\circ}13'$, a distance of three hundred and seventy five feet, more or less, to the east line of said donation land claim in said section, township and range. The spiral curves hereinabove mentioned are those known as Searles' Railroad Spirals.
