

Quartz Mining Location Notice

Notice is hereby given that VIRGINIA L. CREECH, the undersigned citizen or _____ of the United States, conforming to the mining laws thereof and the State of Washington, and the local rules, regulations and customs of miners, has this 19th day of April, 1970, located and do claim Fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein, bearing mineral in place, by Six hundred feet in width, the same being Three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, and the same not having heretofore located, to the best of her knowledge and belief.
