This Mortgage made this 8th day of June 1912 by C.C. Woodward and Almina Woodward his wife, H.E. Poe and Esther Poe his wife and P.T. Deveraux and Ella J. Deveraux his wife, hereinafter called the mortgagors, to E.H. Dodge hereinafter called the mortgagee, Witnesseth: That the said mortgagors, for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000.00) to the mortgagors paid by the mortgagee do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee that certain real property situate in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

All of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section six (6) and all of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section seven (7) and all of the west half of the North East quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and all of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section eighteen (18) in Township two (2) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian; also all of the south half of the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ of S $\frac{1}{2}$) and all of the Northeast quarter of section one (1) in Township two (2) North of Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian containing six hundred sixty seven (667) acres more or less all lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington together with all the timber standing and lying and being upon said lands above described.
