Porter, party of the second part, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, the following described real property situate lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The South east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section four (4) in Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing eighty (80) acres.

To Have and to Hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Mary Christine Edwards and George M.
